

Tennessee Foreclosure Trends: March 2009

How many/where/patterns

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According to the latest data from RealtyTrac® *US Foreclosure Market Report*, Tennessee reported 4,421 foreclosure filings¹ in March 2009, a 20 percent increase from the previous month (February 2009), and a 75 percent increase from the same month last year (March 2008). Total foreclosure filings in Tennessee accounted for 1.30 percent of 341,180 foreclosure filings in the nation. In terms of total foreclosure filings, the U.S., as a whole, had a 17 percent increase from February 2009, and a 46 percent increase from March 2008. There was one foreclosure filing for every 616 households, which puts Tennessee in 16th place in the nation (national average was 1 filing for 375 households).

The total foreclosure filings in three major counties (Davidson, Knox and Shelby) accounted for 61 percent of total foreclosure filings in the State in March 2009. Shelby County ranked as number one among all counties in Tennessee both in terms of the ratio of foreclosure filings to households (1 foreclosure filings for every 195 households), and also in terms of total number of foreclosure filings (2,041 properties with foreclosure filings), followed by Sevier county with 1 filing for every 382 households. In Shelby County, total foreclosure filings were 43 percent higher than the last month and 87 percent higher than the same month last year (March 2008). The county with the second highest total number of properties with foreclosure filings was Davidson (427), followed by Knox County (236) and Hamilton County (198). Hancock, Moore, and Pickett Counties did not have any properties with foreclosure filings in March 2009.

¹ For Tennessee RealtyTrac's report incorporates documents filed in two phases of foreclosure: Auction — Notice of Trustee Sale (NTS); and Real Estate Owned, or REO properties (that have been foreclosed on and repurchased by a bank).
