

Tennessee Foreclosure Trends: April 2010

How many/where/patterns

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
According to the latest data from the RealtyTrac® *US Foreclosure Market Report*, Tennessee reported 4,789 properties with foreclosure filings¹ in April 2010. This volume represents no change from the previous month (March 2010) and a 38 percent increase from the same month last year (April 2009).

The total number of properties with foreclosure filings in Tennessee accounted for one percent of the 333,837 foreclosure filings in the nation. In Tennessee, the properties with foreclosure filings ranged from zero in Hancock and Scott Counties to 1,613 in Shelby County.

In terms of the total number of properties with foreclosure filings, the U.S. had a 9 percent decline from March 2010, and a two percent decline from April 2009. On average, there was one filing for every 387 housing units in the nation. Nevada ranked number one in the nation with one foreclosure filing for every 69 housing units. Tennessee had one foreclosure filing for every 576 housing units, putting the State in 22nd place in the nation.

¹ For Tennessee, RealtyTrac's report (http://relatytrac.com/trendcenter/) incorporates documents filed in two phases of foreclosure: Auction — Notice of Trustee Sale (NTS); and Real Estate Owned (REO) properties that have been foreclosed on and repurchased by a bank.

In April 2010, there were 2,510 properties with Notice of Trustee Sales (NTS), a nine percent increase from the last month and a 20 percent increase from the same month last year (April 2009). 2,279 properties were repossessed by the lender (REOs) in April 2010, a nine percent decline from the last month (March 2010) and a 65 percent increase from April 2009.



The total foreclosure filings in four counties (Davidson, Hamilton, Knox, and Shelby) accounted for 54 percent of the total foreclosure filings in the State in April 2010. Shelby County ranked as number one among all counties in Tennessee both by the ratio of foreclosure filings to housing units (1 foreclosure filing for every 249 housing units) and by the number of properties with foreclosure filings (1,613 properties). The total volume of foreclosure filings in Shelby County increased by 26 percent from the previous month and by 14 percent from the same month last year (April 2009). The county with the second highest number of properties with foreclosure filings was Davidson (429), followed by Knox County (298) and Hamilton County (228).

Compared to March 2010, the total number of properties with foreclosure filings decreased in April 2010 in Davidson, Knox, and Hamilton Counties by 27 percent, five percent, and four percent, respectively. 55 counties recorded declines in foreclosure filings from last month, while 33 counties had increases. Seven counties did not see any change in the number of properties with foreclosure filings.
