- SUBJECT: Clarification of "Watersense" Requirement
- DATE: December 10, 2019

"Watersense" requirements have been included in the THDA Qualified Allocation Plans for the Low-Income Housing Credit Program since 2013. The purpose of this memo is to clarify that the Watersense requirement for faucets <u>only applies to bathroom faucets</u>. This clarification applies to the following language in each Qualified Allocation Plan ("QAP"):
