

Tennessee Foreclosure Trends: Q3-2009

How many/where/patterns

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According to the latest data from RealtyTrac® *US Foreclosure Market Report*, Tennessee reported 10,888 foreclosure filings¹ in the third quarter of 2009, a four percent increase from the previous quarter (Q2_09), and a 14 percent increase from the same quarter last year (Q3_09). The total number of properties with foreclosure filings in Tennessee accounted for 1.16 percent of 937,840 foreclosure filings in the nation. In terms of total foreclosure filings the U.S. had a five percent increase from Q2_09, and 23 percent increase from the third quarter of 2009.

There was one foreclosure filing for every 250 households, which puts Tennessee in 22nd place in the nation (national average was one filing for 136 households). The state with the highest foreclosure rate in the third quarter of 2009 was Nevada with one filing for every 23 housing units.

The total foreclosure filings in four major counties (Davidson, Hamilton, Knox and Shelby) accounted for 54 percent of total foreclosure filings in the State in Q3 2009. Shelby County ranked as number one among all counties in Tennessee both in terms of ratio (one foreclosure filings for every 113 households) and in terms of total number of foreclosure filings (3,519 foreclosure filings). In Shelby County, total foreclosure filings were seven percent lower than the last quarter and 10 percent lower than the same quarter last year (Q3_08). The county with the second highest foreclosure total was Davidson (1,156), followed by Knox County (647) and Hamilton County (584).
