

Tennessee Foreclosure Trends: Q4-2009

How many/where/patterns

According to the latest data from the RealtyTrac® *US Foreclosure Market Report*, Tennessee reported 11,135 foreclosure filings¹ in the fourth quarter of 2009, a two percent increase from the previous quarter (Q3_09), and a 10 percent increase from the same quarter last year (Q4_08). The total number of properties with foreclosure filings in Tennessee accounted for 1.28 percent of 869,346 foreclosure filings in the nation. In terms of total foreclosure filings the U.S. had a seven percent decline from Q3_09, and an 18 percent increase from the fourth quarter of 2008. There was one foreclosure filing for every 245 housing units, which puts Tennessee in 21st place in the nation (national average was one filing for 147 housing units).

The total foreclosure filings in four counties (Davidson, Hamilton, Knox and Shelby) accounted for 53 percent of total foreclosure filings in the State in Q4 2009. Shelby County ranked as number one among all counties in Tennessee both in terms of ratio (one foreclosure filings for every 114 housing units) and total number of foreclosure filings (3,504 foreclosure filings). In Shelby County, total foreclosure filings did not change from the last quarter and declined by eight percent from the same quarter last year (Q4_08). The county with the second highest foreclosure total was Davidson (1,155), followed by Knox County (664) and Hamilton County (581). While all three counties had increasing number of properties with foreclosure filings compared to the same quarter last year, they did not have substantial changes from the last quarter (Q3-09). Only Knox County had a three percent decline from the previous quarter, while Davidson County stayed the same and Hamilton had a slight decline of one percent. In 42 counties, the total number of properties with foreclosure filings declined from the previous quarter, while in 47 counties, the number increased. Six counties did not have any change.
