SUBJECT:	Subgrantee Opt-In to Reduce Bidding Period from Ten to Five Business Days

Purpose: The current program year is continuing to experience challenges that will likely impede program performance for an extended period of time. The reduced bidding period will potentially allow a greater number of bids to be awarded in a shorter amount of time.

Guidance: Subgrantees may opt to reduce the number of days a bid is posted from ten to five business days. This reduction can only be granted after request from the subgrantee; it is a temporary alternative to the current policy and *will remain active until at least June 30, 2024*.

Subgrantees interested in requesting this alternative will complete the attached form and return to THDA. Upon THDA's confirmation of receipt, the subgrantee may begin using a five day posting for all jobs yet to be bid.

The option to reduce bidding period is a THDA WAP policy and all other local, state, and federal procurement policies must still be followed.
