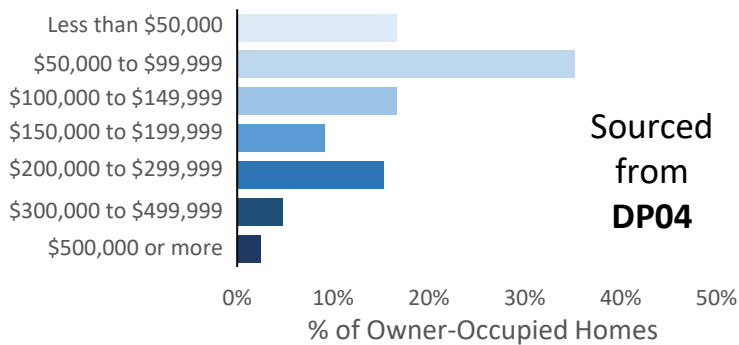


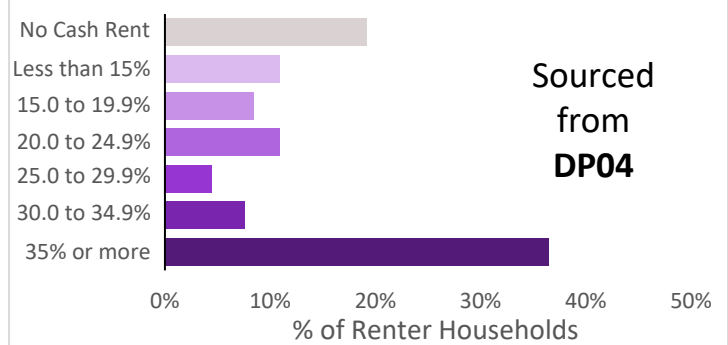

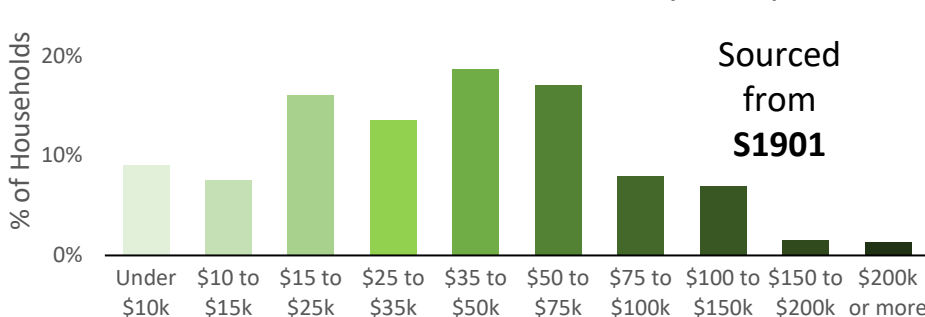
Value of Owner-Occupied Homes



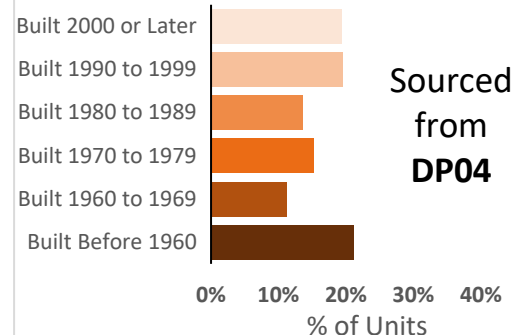
Gross Rent as a % of Household Income
