

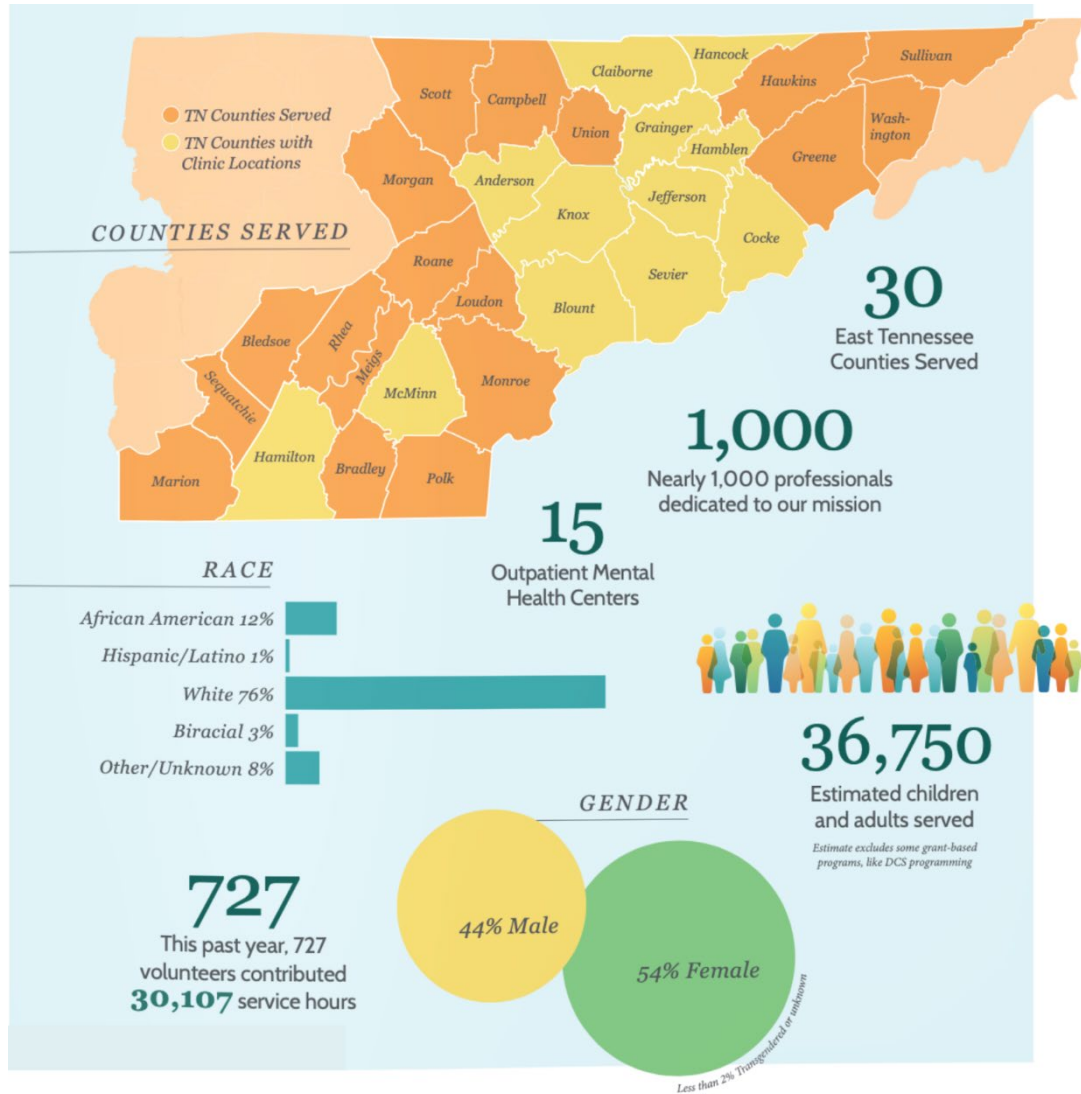

MCNABB CENTER - BY THE NUMBERS



The Center offers traditional housing, transitional housing, supported housing and residential treatment. This includes:

- **207 units of safe, affordable, permanent housing for individuals with existing mental health diagnoses**
- **148 residential treatment and shelter beds for crisis stabilization, residential foster care, medically monitored detox, residential substance use treatment, domestic violence, intensive long-term supportive housing and other specialized programs**

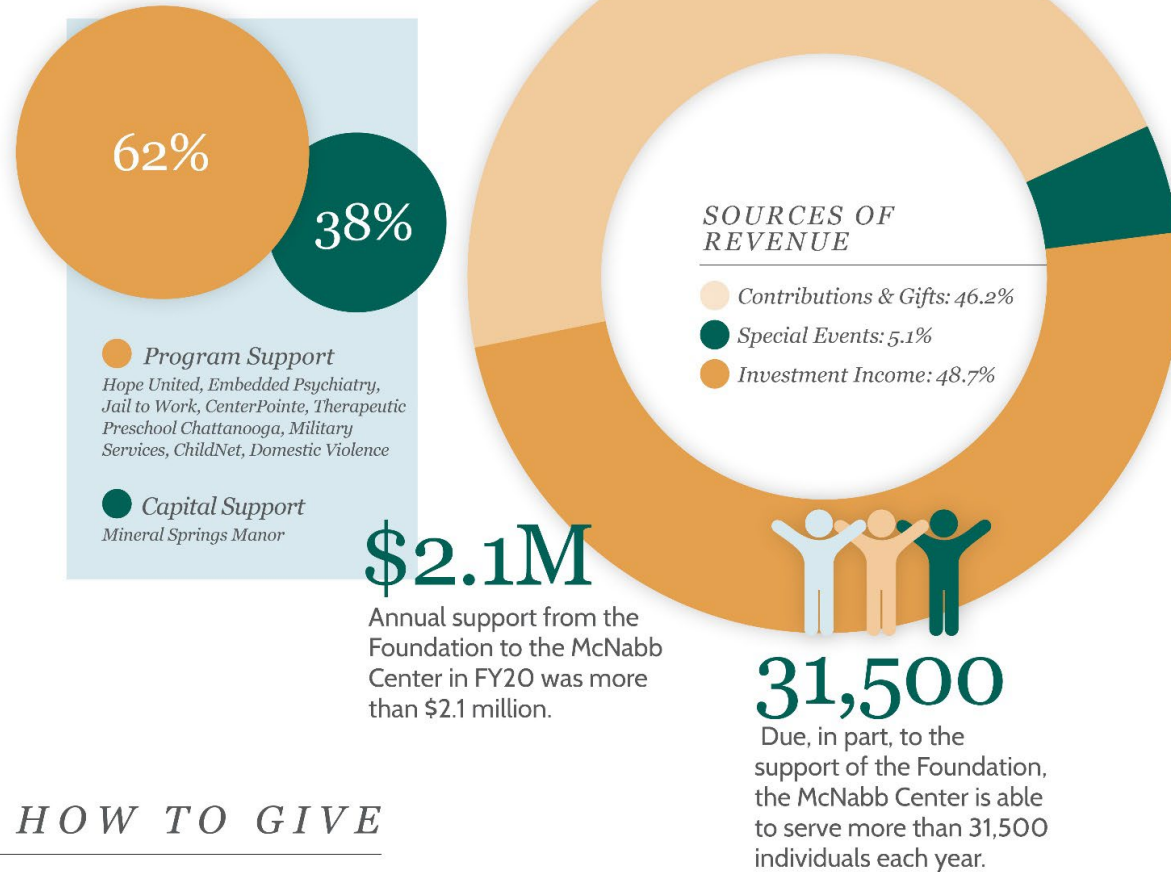

In 2020, the Foundation's assets approached \$40 million, growing by more than \$8 million.



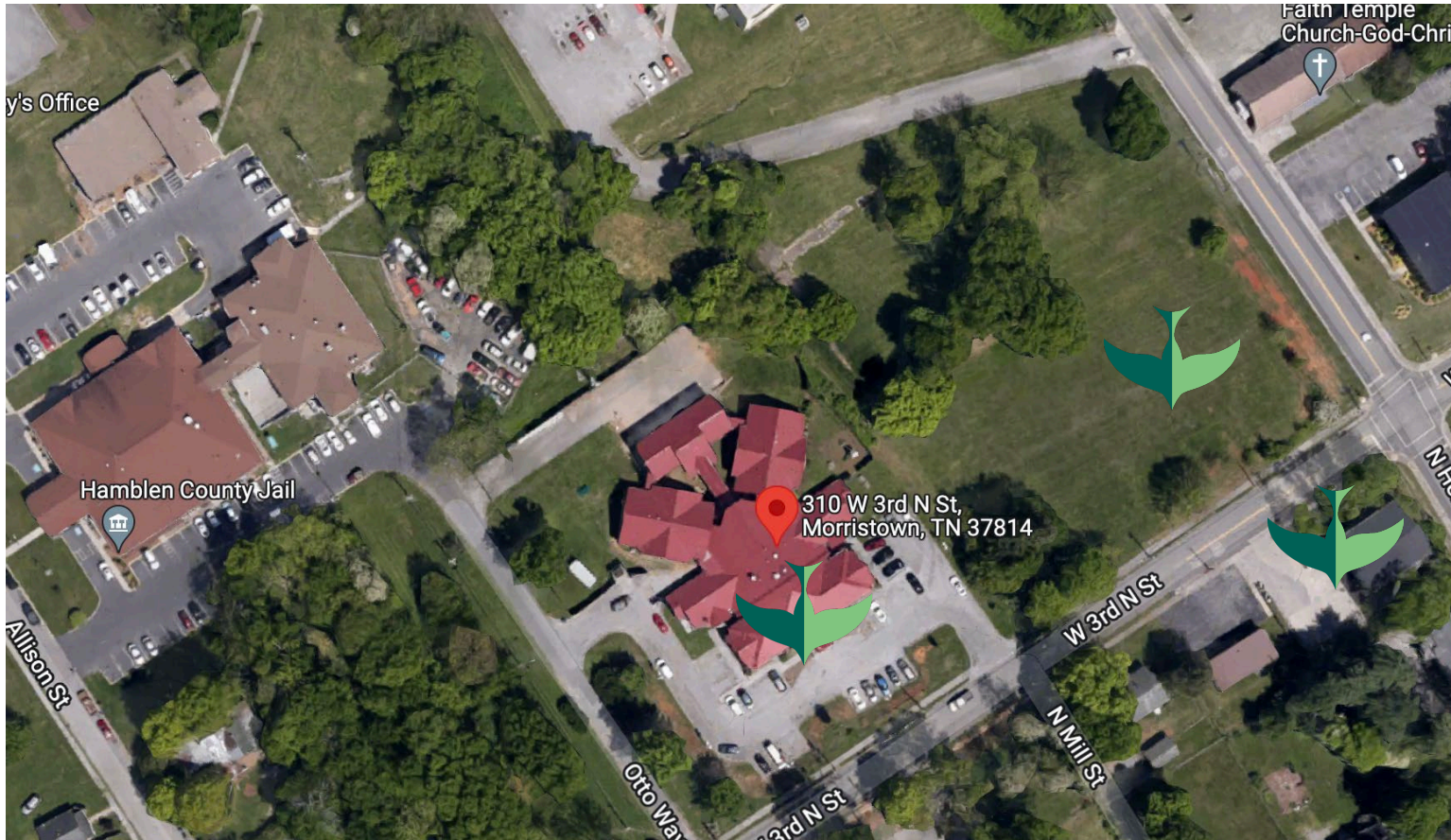
HOW TO GIVE

- **10 annual fundraising events netting around \$900,000.**
- **\$49 Million in total assets 12-31-2021 from \$5.9 million in net assets on 7-1-2008.**
- **Full time development team of six staff members.**
- **Independent volunteer board of directors from a multi-county area.**
- **Has provided funding for more than 90% of the clinics, housing and other facilities the McNabb Center currently owns, excluding mergers.**

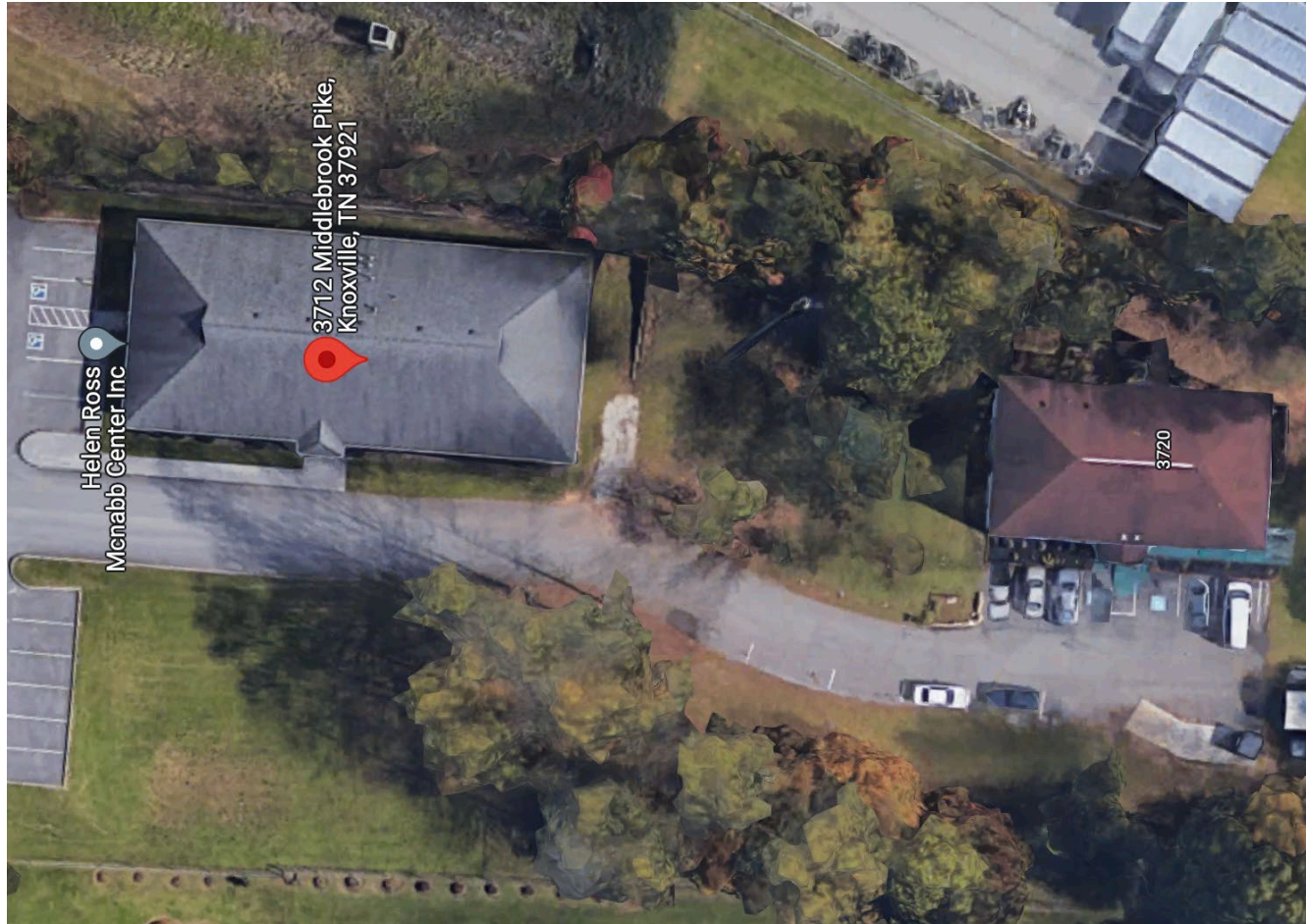
