Medicare does pay for...

- Part A pays for hospital
- Part B pays for outpatient and some equipment
- Part D pays for medications
- Medicare covers temporary home health
- Medicare covers doctor home visits for homebound
- Short Term rehabilitation/therapy





Medicare does not pay for Custodial/permanent services.


- Take a bath alone

- Assisted Living in a facility starts at \$3500/mo


- Meals on Wheels

- Bathing staff






How DO I Use my house to take care of me? Can the state "take my house"?

- Long-Term care of individuals who need 24 hour care in a Nursing Home Residence costs \$10,000/month
- In-Home Care with CHOICES/Long Term Medicaid
- Lien on home sale funds
- Caregiver allowable
