To Our Valued Partners and Customers:

As many of you are probably aware, there is a critical vulnerability that was announced with Apache's log4j java-based logging component. It scored the highest score possible on potential exploitability due to how easy of an exploit it is and that it would give the attacker complete control of the compromised system.

THDA has reviewed our internal and external developed systems used in serving our customers and partners and determined that the log4j vulnerability does not impact any proprietary THDA software, primarily due to the fact we develop software using Microsoft .NET, which does not use Java.

Therefore, at this time, we are happy to say that the log4j vulnerability does not apply to any THDA developed software.
